Provide Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) certificate is an Australian Nationally Recognised Qualification. It covers the legal requirements for a person to work in a bar serving alcohol. It focuses on the areas of identifying intoxicated customers, customer service with attention to refusal of service to patrons, compliance with legal issues and assisting customers to drink sensibly.

This course is designed to be undertaken for persons who currently working or seeking work in the hospitality industry. It is a requirement in Australia that all staff working in venues that sell alcoholic beverages undertake this course. This course allows participants to understand and comply with the legal responsibilities associated with the service of alcohol and harm minimisation.

COURSE DURATION: 3-4 hours of self-paced learning through e-learning portal, face to face teaching and scenarios. A statement of attainment will be issued to participants who successfully completed all assessments. Participants must have at least intermediate level of English to partake this course.
